LAWN CARE

- Mow your lawn as long as your grass is growing.
- Rake your lawn and gardens clean of leaves and debris. Add fallen leaves, old plant parts and grass clippings to the compost pile, if you have one.
- Fescue Lawns: Establish new grass seed this month with aeration and fertilization. Apply New Lawn Starter Fertilizer. Apply with fescue grass seed. Aerate if necessary and lightly cover your new seed with Coast of Maine Black Earth Lawn Soil or other tackifier to help adhere.
- Centipede Lawns: Apply Hi-Yield Muriate of Potash, an excellent source of Potassium, to establish healthy roots and stems.
- Warm Season Lawns: Apply Hi-Yield Turf & Ornamental Weed & Grass Stopper, providing pre-emergent control or suppression of listed weeds.
