Watering Tips

The first 18 months after planting is the most critical.

Morning is the best time to water.

To avoid water runoff, slow deep watering is essential for the health of the plant.

Watering should be more frequent during periods of drought or heavy winds.

Adequate Rain

Rain is only sufficient when 1-2" has fallen.

Remember roots are confined to a small area.

Watering needs to be at the base of the plant.



Test Soil

Not enough water is harmful for the plant but too much water is also harmful.

Moist is different than soggy, and you can judge this by feel (putting finger down into the soil).

Damp soil that dries for a short time is best and will allow adequate oxygen to permeate the soil.



Spring-Summer:

For #3-7 gallon size plants -slow trickle every 3-4 days - total of 1" per week. For larger size, #10-25 gallon plants, they need 35-45 minutes with a slow trickle at the base of the plant. Soaker hoses are great for this application.

Fall-Winter

For #3-7 gallon size plants - water once per week (if we don't get 1" or more of rain). For #10-25 gallon size plants, 35-45 minutes with a slow trickle or soaker hose at the base of the plant.

Annuals/Perennials

Watering requirements for these plants can vary significantly from plant to plant. For this reason, it is important to inquire about the plants watering needs. Some planning will also help- such as by grouping plants with similar water requirements-to avoid potential problems before they start.

Plant Warranty

Success with your new plant is tied directly to the amount of care it is given. Our policy is a 50-50 partnership with the customer. Policy
