STEP 1 Mid FEB & Late MAR

Provides pre-emergent control of Crabgrass and control or suppression of other listed weeds when applied prior to germination and emergence. Can be applied up to 4 weeks later than other pre-emergent Crabgrass preventers.



STEP 2 Early MAY
